I am writing to request your track team's participation in the **6th Annual Robert S. Shumake Scholarship Relays**, being held on **Saturday, April 24, 2010 at a Renaissance High School**. This meet has become the premier annual track and field competition for high school athletes from America.

This competition is the brainchild of Mr. Robert S. Shumake, a Detroit business owner who attributes his success to both his education at Edwin Denby High School in Detroit and the critical skills he developed there as a student athlete on the track and field team. He was able to apply discipline, dedication, perseverance and teamwork to his business pursuits to realize his goals. Mr. Shumake now desires to give back to his community and to assist student athletes.

The Robert S. Shumake Scholarship Relays differs from other prominent track and field competitions given its dual focus and recognition of athletic *and* academic achievement.

- Athletic Achievement

 - Medals for the top 8 places in every event.
- Academic Achievement
 - Girl and boy with the highest GPA on each team awarded a souvenir back pack.
 - Students attending schools that participate in the competition are eligible to apply for scholarships up to \$2,500 to attend college.

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Shumake Relays Scholarship Information

The Robert S. Shumake Family Foundation has awarded over \$30,000 in scholarships to high school students since 2005. The Thurgood Marshall Foundation (TMF) is the administrator for the Robert S. Shumake Scholarship Award and serves as the fiduciary of the scholarships. The application process is administered exclusively online and funds for the scholarship winners are distributed directly to the college in which the scholar is attending. *The 2010 Robert S. Shumake Scholarship is a one-time award up to \$2,500 given to students in their freshman year attending a four year accredited college of their choice.* **Encourage your student athletes to apply at www.shumakerelays.com or www.thurgoodmarshallfund.org.**

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Student must attend a school, which participated in the Robert S. Shumake Scholarship Relays on Saturday, April 24, 2010 to receive the maximum scholarship funding.
- Student must complete and submit this Robert S. Shumake Scholarship Essay Application Form (see next section).
- Student must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale.
- Student must be accepted and ultimately attend a 4-year accredited institution as a first semester freshman.
- **Student must submit all the required application materials by the application deadline Monday, March 29, 2010.**

II. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- Student must submit an official high school transcript.
- Student must submit two (2) letters of recommendation, at least one from a school official and one from a community organization (such as a church, charity/social service organization).
- Student must submit a 250-word essay on “The Importance of EDUCATION, HOMEOWNERSHIP AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP”.

III. APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Student must complete the application online and include all required documentation. Applications without required documentation will not be considered and will be discarded.
- Supporting documents must be **post marked in regular mail no later than Monday, March 29, 2010- NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- **Scholarship winners will be announced on Saturday, April 24, 2010.**
- Winners are further honored at the “*Banquette of Champions*”. Details provided by The Robert S. Shumake Foundation office.
- All winners are required to attend an accredited university or college in order to receive this award.
